Cost per person is \$95 and includes your show ticket, lunch, bus ride and driver tip.




"Drinking Habits" at Daytrippers Theatre

"Newsies" The Broadway Musical at Chanhassen Dinner Theater


With astounding choreography, unforgettable songs and inspirational storytelling, Newsies is a not-to-be-missed, high-energy show for all ages.




Barns, Brews & Kangaroos
